In the period **1640 – 1657**, two sons of Cornelius emigrated tot the New Netherlands as the first pioneers within the family. One to Albany, New York and the other to Catskill, New York.

1. **Gijsbert Cornelisz Bogaert** van Catskill, New York (born1628),
2. **Cornelis Corneliszn Bogaert** van Albany, New York (born1630),

In 1652 their cousin **Theunis Gijsbertszn Bogaert** of Brooklyn (born1632), son of Gijsbert Theuniszn Bogaert also emigrated to Brooklyn, New York.

In 1663 their cousin **Jan Laurens Bogaert** of Harlem, (geb.1625), Son of Louw Theuniszn Bogaert also emigrated to Harlem, New York
